TITLE: Basic Defensive Tactics Instructor School

DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this school is to provide the student with training that develops each student's ability to gain the skills necessary to become a certified instructor. It is intended to motivate and present a combined system of skills and attitudes, and to advance new ideas coupled with existing technique.

PRE-REQUISITES: Students exhibiting preexisting medical problems that instructional staff believe could likely lead to injury will be returned to their agency without training. Individuals should be in good health and able to participate in strenuous exercises. A medical examination is recommended.

Participants will be required to perform push-ups, sit-ups, and a one mile run. In addition, they will be subjected to mental stress, physical stress, and physical confrontations with instructors and other participants.

Participants should be sworn law enforcement officers.

PRIORITY: The above deadline for submission of application will be strictly observed as class size is limited. Participants will be selected according to the order in which responses are received.

IN-SERVICE CREDIT: 64 hours of career development in-service credit will be awarded upon successful completion.

TUITION: No charge.

MEALS: Not provided by the Virginia State Police Academy and is the participant's responsibility.

LODGING: Not provided by the Virginia State Police Academy.

ATTIRE: Academy rules prohibit wearing jeans, T-shirts, and shirts without collars, shorts, sweatshirts, sweatpants, tennis shoes, and flip flops.

PARKING: Attendees should park in designated areas and not in front of the Academy or reserved parking areas.

DEADLINE: **July 31, 2015**, at close of business, to submit application.

ACCEPTANCE: Individuals will be notified whether they have been selected to attend this training. Accepted applicants will receive an information packet (what to bring, etc.). Please review closely.
