

Safety Inspector License Testing Sites

Inspector testing will resume on June 1, 2020; however, the following modifications have been made to the testing process to protect the health and safety of both the inspectors and troopers involved in this process:

- Pursuant to and in accordance with Inspection Bulletin #408 (March 18, 2020), the 90 day extension for inspector licenses which expired during the months of March, April, and which have or will expire in May remains effective.

Month of Expiration	Ninety Day Extension Expiration

April 30, 2020	July 31, 2020
May 31, 2020	August 31, 2020

- Inspector testing and recertification testing will be conducted on designated days determined by each Area Office.
- Each applicant or currently certified inspector will be responsible for contacting their local Safety Division Area Office to schedule a testing date and time. (See contact information listed below)

- There will be a maximum of ten (10) seats available during each designated testing time. Please note that some Area Offices may have the ability to provide two (2) testing sessions on selected dates. These times would include a morning testing session and an afternoon testing session.
- Test-takers will be asked a series of questions to determine if they are currently experiencing any illness or symptoms of COVID-19. If a test-taker is sick, he/she will not be allowed to test at that time. He/she may attempt to take the test again after 14 days.
- It will be mandatory for each test-taker to bring and wear their own protective face covering as recommended by Executive Order 63 (nose and mouth covering).
- Each test-taker should bring a copy of the Motor Vehicle Inspection Manual.
- Each test-taker should bring writing utensils to prevent the sharing of pencils or pens.
- It is recommended that test-takers bring hand sanitizer.
