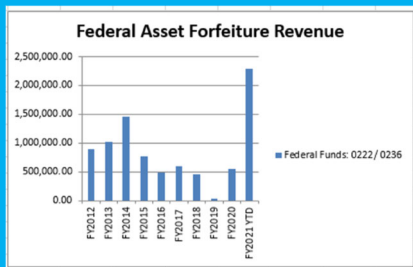

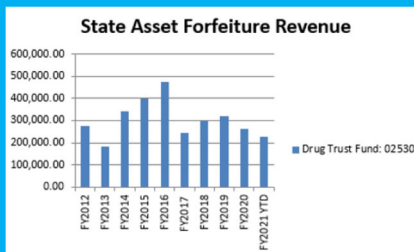
Currently there are three (3) vacant Senior Grant Accountant positions.

Seized Assets

The Department of Justice and the Department of the Treasury Asset Forfeiture Programs are federal law enforcement programs to remove criminal organizations, deprive wrongdoers of the proceeds of their crimes, recover property of victims, and deter crime.

Voyager Card Renewal

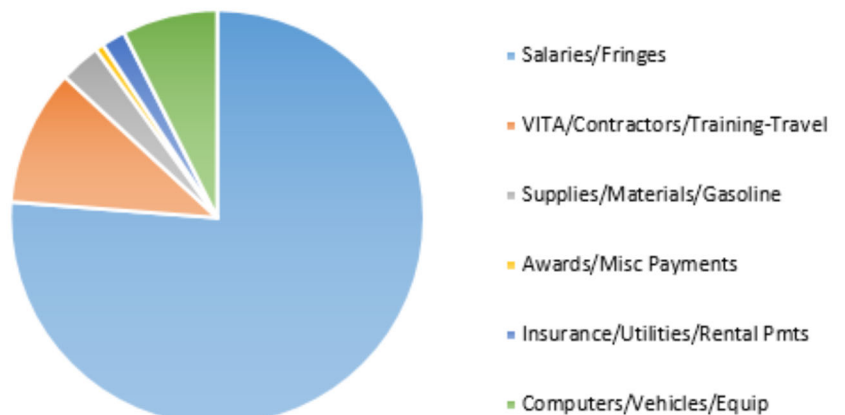
The Virginia State Police recently received new Voyager cards for Department personnel. Warehouse personnel will separate cards by Division and Area for distribution during the month of June, as current Voyager cards will expire at midnight on June 30, 2021. Storekeepers from Divisions 2, 4, and 7 who are designated to come to the Warehouse in June can pick up their Voyager cards, whereas, representatives from Divisions 1, 3, 5, and 6 can receive their Voyager cards after consulting with Warehouse Manager, First Sgt. Brian Best, on a convenient date and time. Warehouse Supervisor, Stacey Waters, will deliver the new Voyager cards to offices within SPHQ.

Important to note that your Voyager card's number will remain the same. Therefore, once you receive your new Voyager card, you can destroy the expired one. **Please do not return the old Voyager cards to the Warehouse.**

The new Voyager card looks different from the previously issued Voyager card. The new Voyager card will not have "Commonwealth of Virginia" at the top with a country road and forest background but will have a blue background with the name "usbank" at the top left hand corner and the word "FLEET" underneath it. In addition, the Department requested "swipe" cards, rather than the EMV chipped Fleet fuel cards issued since January 1, 2020.
